## Deposit Fee and Contract for 2023-24 SY

### Due May 1

Families returning next year will need to pay your May 2024 Tuition (non-refundable) Deposit Fee by May 1. Payment notices will be in your returned registration packet and will be placed in your child's mail pouch on April 17th and 18th. The deposit fee and contract must be turned in by May 1st to reserve your enrollment for next year.
