**When Fairfax County Schools are CLOSED due to inclement weather or other reasons, VBCC will be CLOSED.**

**When Fairfax County Schools have a 2 hour delay in opening, VBCC opens at 11:30.**

**When Fairfax County schools close 2 hours early, VBCC closes at 12:30. Please use your best judgment when Fairfax County calls for an early release. If you feel it is best to come and get your child early please do so. However, you must be here for pick up no later than 12:30 when early release is called for Fairfax County Schools.**
