

dates. More information on ordering class pictures will be emailed in April.




#### **Financial Notes**



A FEW REMINDERS:

- The <u>April tuition payment</u> will be the <u>last tuition payment for</u> <u>this school year</u> for most parents. Last year, when most of our parents registered, they paid a Deposit Fee which is the tuition for May 2023.
- If you plan to return next year, the amount that you will owe by **May 1st** will be the tuition for May 2024. A payment notice will be sent out to remind you of the amount.
- Please remember to make an <u>adjustment to your automatic</u> <u>payments</u> for the Deposit tuition for May 2024 if you are planning to return to VBCC.
- Please include your child's name on the check memo line if different from your last name or if a double name family.
- Please remember to notify our office if you change bank accounts or get a new credit card number that you are using to make automatic tuition payments.
