Important Reminders:

Please check your child's mail pouch every day for important VBCC information.

Please be sure to inform the office of any change of address, phone numbers and email addresses.

Please make sure to park in a parking space in the main parking lot. The fire lanes in front and to the side of the building should be free from cars at all times. There is no drop off or pick up in that area.

Please label all peanut butter alternatives. We will call if it has no label to make sure it is safe to have at school.

Please bring all birthday treats to the office so we can make sure they are school safe. They must say school safe, be free from nuts, and not processed in a nut factory. They usually carry them at Giant or Whole Foods. We also welcome popsicles for birthday celebrations.

Please do not let children play in the memorial garden located to the left of the front doors. It is a special area for the church.

Christmas is coming and Vienna Baptist Church and Vienna Baptist Children's Center want to see lots of smiles on lots of little faces! We will be working to make that happen at Marshall Road Elementary School again this year by collecting new toys and gifts for 53 Marshall Road students and/or their siblings.

VBCC Snow Policy

Hard to believe that winter is right around the corner, so we wanted to remind everyone of our snow policy: **We follow all Fairfax County weather-related determinations.**

So, when Fairfax County Schools are CLOSED due to inclement weather, VBCC will be CLOSED.

When Fairfax County Schools have a 2 hour delay in opening, VBCC opens at 11:30am.

When Fairfax County Schools close 2 hours early, VBCC closes at 12:30pm.

If Fairfax County calls for a distance learning day due to inclement weather VBCC will be closed.
