VBCC REMINDERS

- Dress for messy play! We love to do a lot of art and play outside so please dress children in clothes that can get dirty.
- Sneakers/Tennis Shoes are best! For everyone's safety on the playground, please send your child in sneakers or tennis shoes.
 Please do not have them come in crocks or sandals.
- Early pick up. If you are picking up your child early please come to the office first so we can get the child from the classroom.
- Lunches! Please remember we have a no candy policy and discourage cookies or juice. A healthy lunch your child would eat and a water bottle work best.
- Birthday celebrations! Please work with your child's teacher to communicate about birthday celebrations. You can bring school safe cupcakes or popsicles directly to the office on the day of the celebration and we will distribute them to the classroom or freezer. Unfortunately we cannot have goodie bags, balloons, or candles.
- Changes in information. Please update the office via email of any changes in address, phone number, or email address so we can have everything correct in our system and class rosters.
- Pick Up. If you arrive early for pick up, please feel free to wait in the Foyer. We ask that parents do not wait near the playground, as we want to keep that area free from any adults other than staff during our school day.

FINANCIAL (



- VBCC tuition and option fees are <u>calculated on an annual basis</u> and divided into 9 equal monthly payments.
- Tuition payments remain the same regardless of absences for any reason.
- Payments are due on the 10th of each month and considered late after the 15th. Automated payment will be deducted on the 15th of each month.
- Checks payable to "VBCC". Mail or drop off payments at the office.
- Deposits are usually made weekly on Fridays.
